## Three-Time Olympian Helps Celebrate a Milestone Achievement

Recently, Maine Highlands FCU was part of a celebration — a big one! At an event that featured **three-time Olympian Devon Harris**, who was one of the inspirations behind the blockbuster movie *Cool Runnings*, the official, record-breaking total for the 2017 Maine Credit Unions' Campaign for Ending Hunger was announced: **\$740,027.35**, a new fundraising milestone.

Harris, who formed a foundation in 2006 which includes helping make sure children have enough to eat so they can do better in school, praised the credit union effort.
