Ending Hunger in Maine

Maine's Credit Unions set another record in 2017 for Ending Hunger by raising \$740,027.35, which is \$65,000 more than last year's record. Through buying power, the funds will enable food pantries and hunger organizations throughout the state to purchase nearly \$7 million worth of food to help Maine's hungry.
