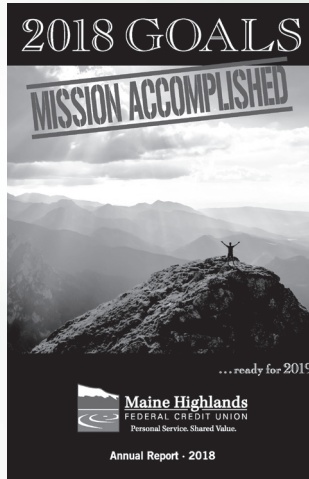

A new record of \$787,360.68 was achieved for total donations from all Credit Unions in Maine for 2018. Maine Highlands FCU came in 10th for most money raised and 8th for per member contributions.
