What is a Dormant Account?

An account becomes "dormant" when there has been no activity for one year. Dividends posted and/or checks cashed do not keep an account from becoming dormant.



What Happens If My Account Becomes Dormant? Your account will be assessed a monthly fee, until the account becomes active or there are no more funds in the account and it will be closed. If more than \$50 remains in the account after August 1 of the third year, you will receive a Due Diligence letter. If you do not respond to this letter, then on November 1 of the

third year, the funds will be turned over to the State of Maine under the "Abandoned Property Law."

How Can I Keep My Account From Becoming Dormant? Make a deposit or withdrawal to or from your account at least once a year. Also, make sure we have your correct address and phone number at all times in case we need to reach you.

Changes to Our Funds Availability Policy Effective 7/1/2020

When check holds apply, amounts made available for withdrawal on the next business day will increase from \$200 to \$225. Amounts made available for withdrawal on exception holds will increase from \$5,000 to \$5,525.
