On November 2, Maine Highlands FCU again closed its **lobbies** at all office locations. With COVID 19 cases on the rise across the state, including the immediate area of all offices, it is imperative that we continue to limit exposure for our employees, as well as members.

Throughout the pandemic, Maine Highlands FCU has encouraged our members to utilize the many remote options that are available to you. This includes opening new accounts and loan applications online, internet and mobile banking, remote deposit capture, ATMs, night deposits, drive-up windows and telephone. These options continue to provide the services needed, while protecting our employees.

If any office is exposed to a positive case of COVID 19, it will need to be closed immediately. It would be at least two to three days before we could reopen, knowing that a thorough cleaning would need to be done. We may also need to move employees from another office to the affected office for coverage since all employees exposed may be required to quarantine for 14 days. I know that this is not what any of us want, but it is what management needs to prepare for in case of such an exposure.
