# What is a Dormant Account?

An account becomes "dormant" when there has been no activity for one year. Dividends posted and/or checks cashed do not keep an account from becoming dormant.



What Happens If My Account
Becomes Dormant? Your account
will be assessed a monthly fee,
until the account becomes active or
there are no more funds in the
account and it will be closed. If more
than \$50 remains in the account
after August 1 of the third year,
you will receive a Due Diligence
letter. If you do not respond to this
letter, then on November 1 of the

third year, the funds will be turned over to the State of Maine under the "Abandoned Property Law."

How Can I Keep My Account From Becoming Dormant? Make a deposit or withdrawal to or from your account at least once per year. Also, make sure we have your correct address and phone number at all times in case we need to reach you.
