# Protecting Yourself from Phishing Scams



Phishing scams are designed to trick you into giving away personal information, like passwords, Social Security numbers, or banking details. Staying alert can keep your accounts, and your identity safe.

## Spot the Red Flags

Be cautious of emails, texts, or calls that create a sense of urgency, ask for personal information, or include suspicious links or attachments. Legitimate organizations, including credit unions, will never request sensitive information this way.

## Verify Before You Click

If a message seems suspicious, contact the company directly using a trusted phone number or website. Don't click links or download attachments from unknown sources.

## Protect Your Accounts

Use strong, unique passwords and enable two-factor authentication whenever possible. Regularly monitor your accounts for unusual activity.

Being cautious and double checking messages can help you avoid phishing scams and keep your personal information secure. Maine Highlands Federal Credit Union is here to answer questions and provide guidance if you suspect a scam.
